Join us for a conversation with Assemblywoman Laura Friedman, representing the 43<sup>rd</sup> AD, which includes Burbank, Glendale and La Canada Flintridge.

Serving her first term in the State Legislature, Laura may be new to the Assembly, but she is a long-time community activist, businesswoman, and elected official, having served as City Councilmember and Mayor of the City of Glendale. Since her election in 2016, she has authored a package of bills to encourage water conservation, strengthen environmental protection, improve access to higher education and health care, and create new avenues for communities to tackle the affordably housing crisis. Most recently, she has been appointed to serve as Chair of the Subcommittee on Sexual Harassment and Prevention and Response, whose mandate is to establish guidelines to reduce incidents of sexual harassment in the Legislature, protect those who report harassment or abuse, and hold perpetrators accountable.
