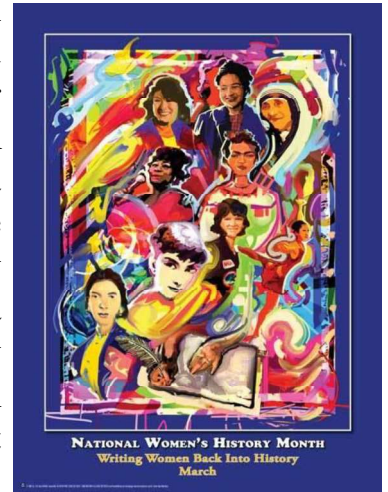


## Women's History Month
