The 1973 landmark Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision stated that the US Constitution protects a women's right to make medical decisions about her own body. In the 2022 Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization case, the current Supreme Court reversed that decision, and now our rights are under assault.
