Keeping Up with Kathryn

In January, we will be speaking with Supervisor Kathryn Barger, who represents the 5th District on the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. The 5th District is home to nearly two million people and covers 2,800 square miles including the Santa Clarita and Antelope Valleys areas - home to our sister branches - whom we have invited to join us for this meeting.



First elected in 2016, Supervisor Barger began her career in public service as a college intern in the office of Supervisor Michael D. Antonovich. She rose to become his chief deputy in 2001, where she served until her election to the Board of Supervisors. Her interests and advocacy include mental health, social services, and children's issues. She is also a strong supporter of the environment and a believer in fiscal responsibility.

Keeping Up with Kathryn is her current newsletter which is chock full of information detailing her board and community activities; we recommend you check it out prior to our meeting. Serving on an all-woman board, which represents 11 million Californians, and is responsible for administering a \$39 billion budget, Supervisor Barger is a role model and advocate for increased representation of Women in Leadership Roles, one of AAUW's public policy priorities.
