As Chair of the LA County League of Women Voters, Margo has been closely following the Governance Reform Task Force established by the Board of Supervisors. As the saying goes, "the devil is in the details," and that aptly describes the work that the Task Force has to execute. Budget oversight, ethics compliance, an elected executive, and increasing the size of the Board are just some of the issues requiring implementation. Ensuring that implementation of Measure G uses existing County funds with no additional taxes or costs to taxpayers is another major challenge. How will this be accomplished?
